The fellow will work in Macrofinance Lab as part of the ECONtribute Excellence Cluster, funded by the Federal Excellence Initiative. The appointment will be for a period of up to three years.

The Macrofinance Lab is a leading research center in the fields of macro-finance, international finance and financial history. It pursues an ambitious research agenda with regular publications in top journals and visibility in the international policy debate. Alumni have joined top economics and finance departments in Europe and North America.

Core research projects are currently funded by the European Research Council (ERC) and the German research foundation (DFG). These projects focus on macrofinance and banking, housing markets, monetary policy and financial stability, international finance, and inequality. The Macrofinance Lab organizes a weekly seminar with distinguished international guests and maintains the Jordà-Schularick-Taylor Macrohistory Database.
